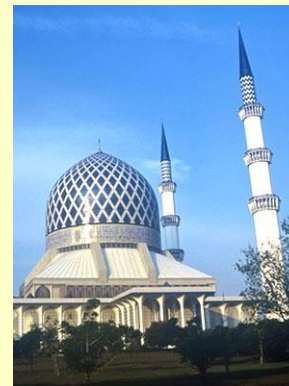
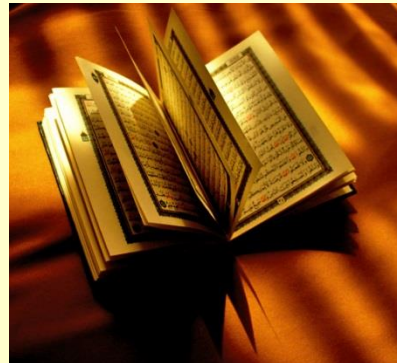

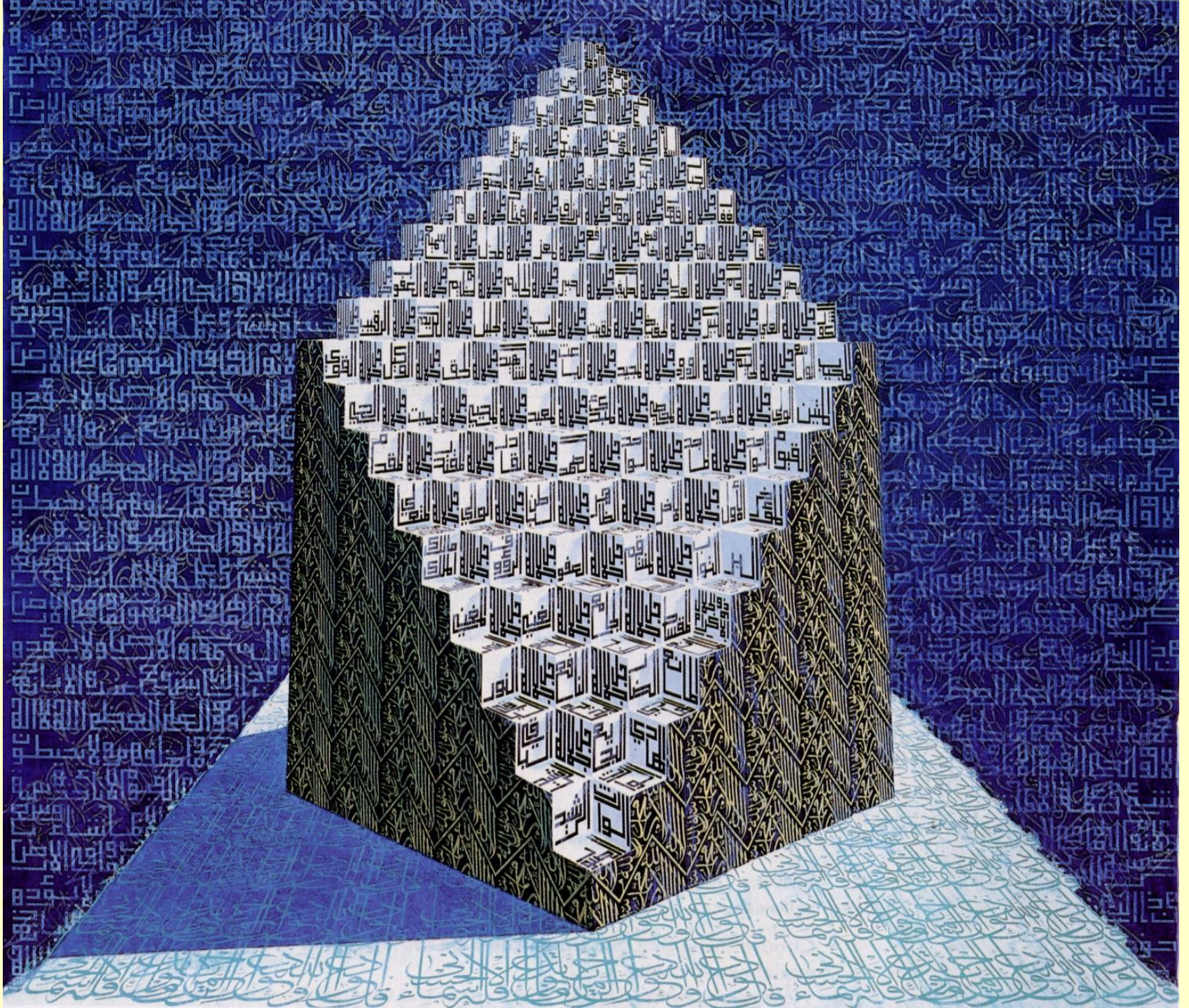
Muslims believe that because Allah is **transcendent**, they cannot fully understand God.

A string of beads that Muslims use when praying to help them remember the 99 names of God.

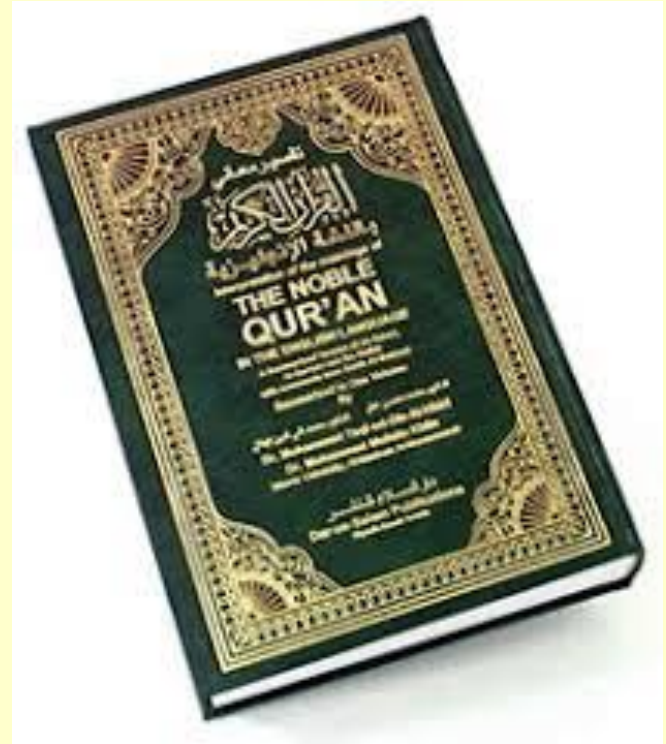


Important characteristics

- **Tawhid** All powerful
- **Immanent** God is close to His creation
- **Omnipotent** God will judge everyone fairly
- **Beneficent** Treats everyone equally
- **All-Merciful** All-loving
- **All-Fair** Oneness of God
- **All-Just** All-forgiving

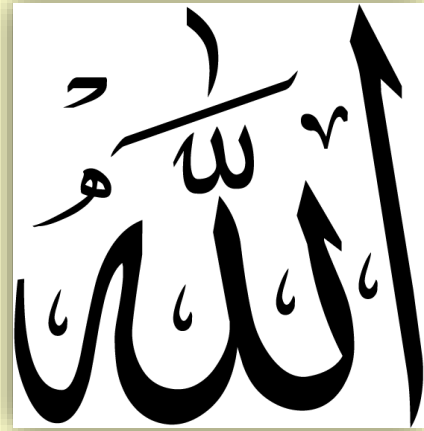
