Father, into Thy hands I commend My spirit.



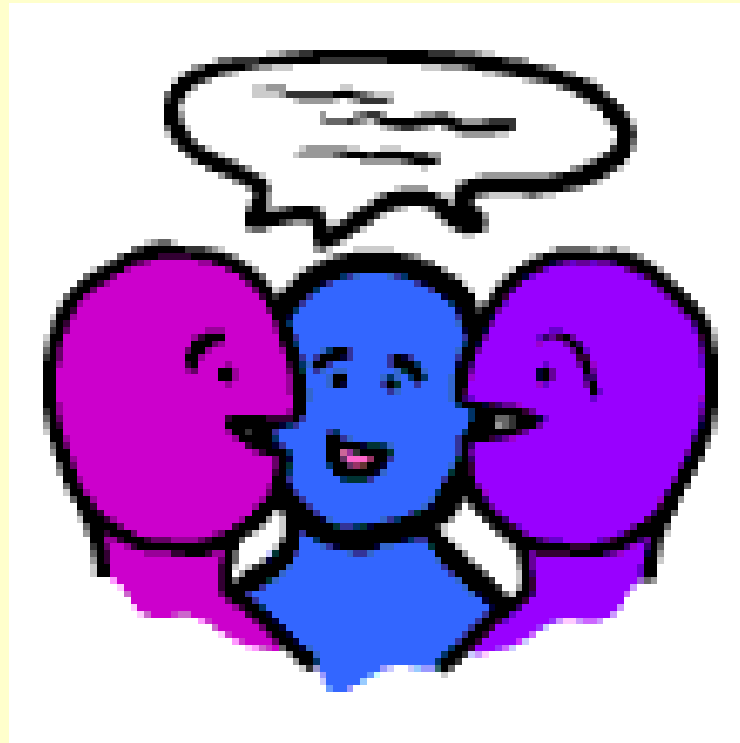

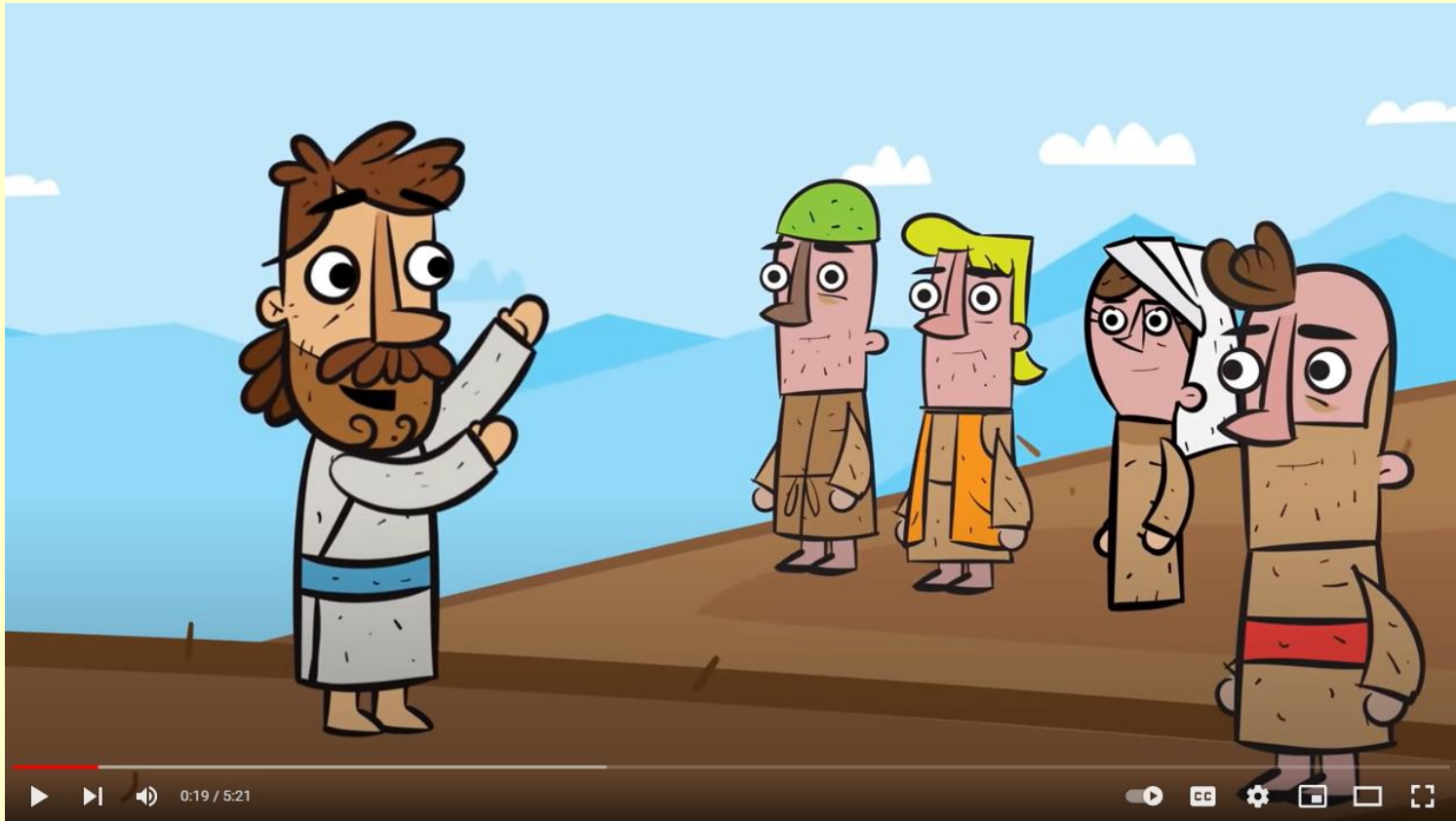
