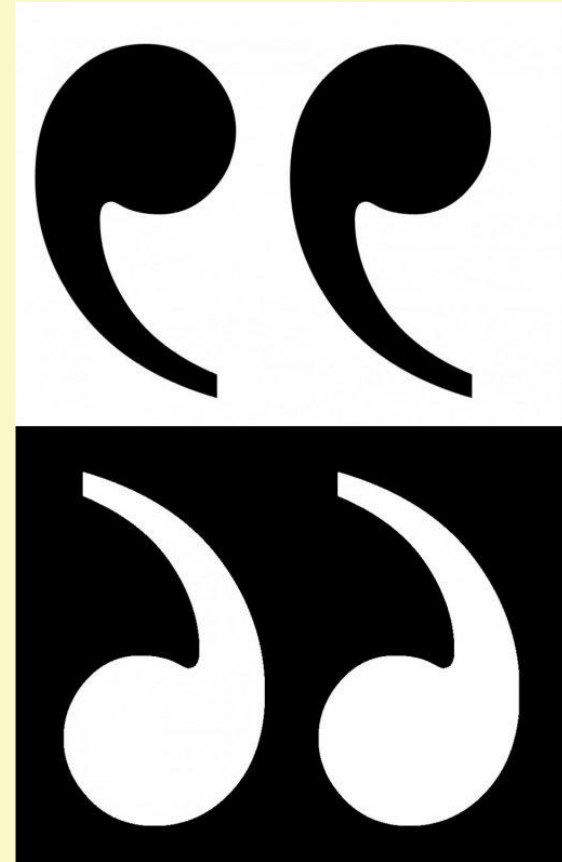

- "The scrolls of Ibrahim"

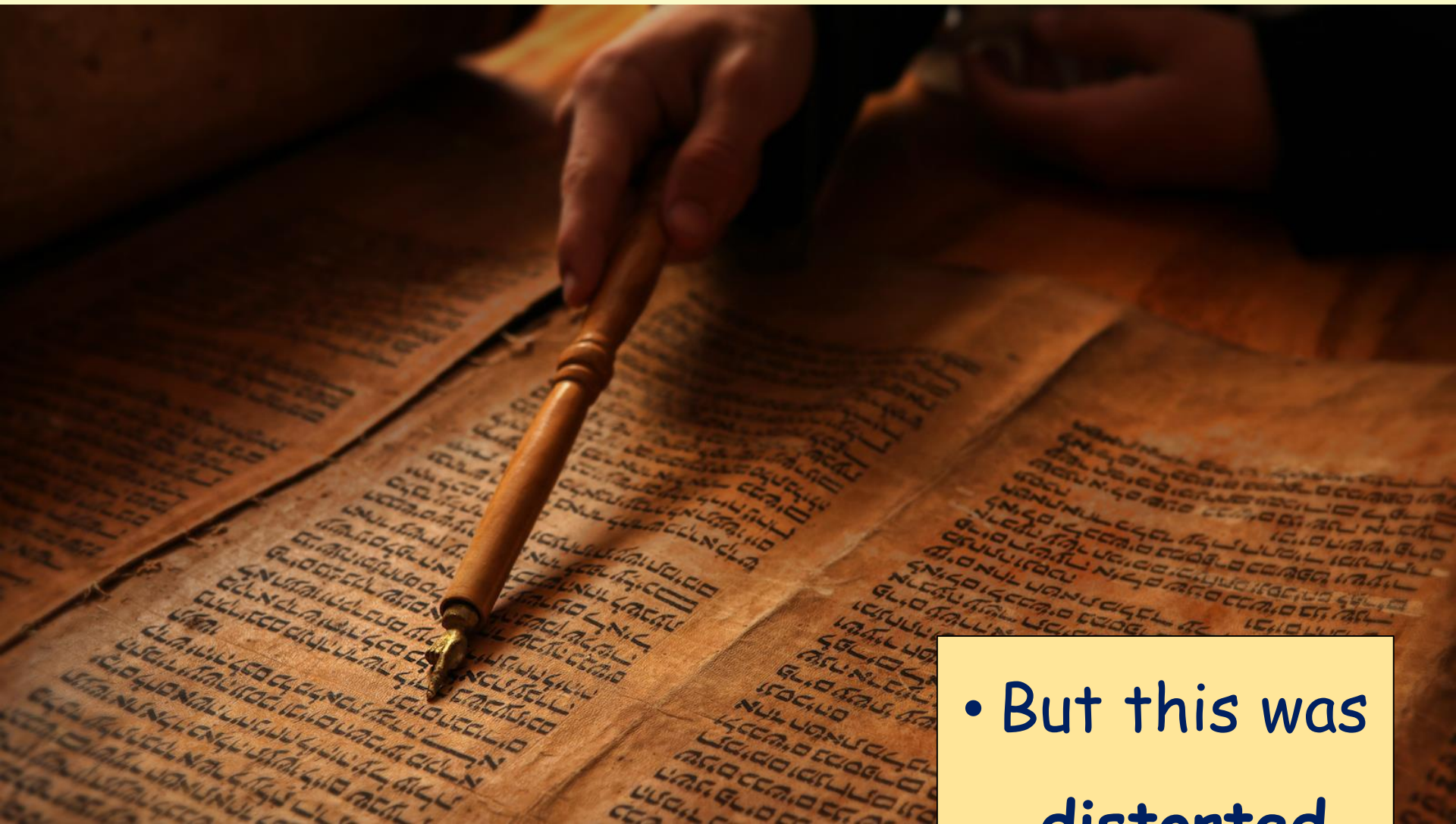
