

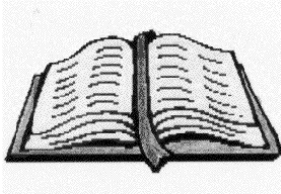

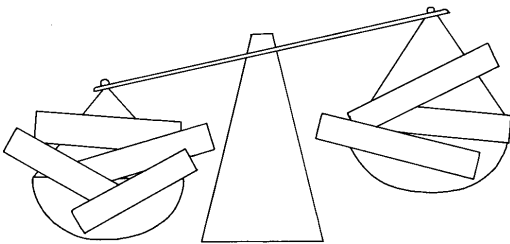
## 2 THE LAST DAY & THE QUR'AN

- When you die, your soul waits in the grave. On the Last Day, your body and soul will be rejoined and raised from the grave
- A trumpet will sound, everything will stop, heaven and earth will totally change, and the raised dead will join the living
- No one except God knows when it will be



## 4 Judgement

- The dead and living will be taken to the **plain of judgement.** They will stand naked before God.
- Each person will be given the book of their life to read out to everyone and God. This is the book made by the angels.
- Only those who have done good things and believed in Islam will get into heaven.

## 1 HUMANKIND

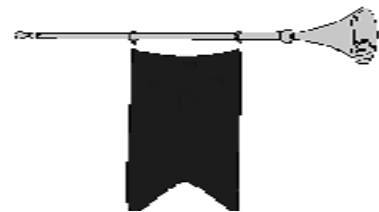
- God made humans thinking and responsible beings.

## 3 THE LAST DAY & TRADITION

The period between death and the Last Day is called Barzakh. There are many different beliefs about Barzakh:

- Some say that when you die, you are visited by Izra'il the angel of death who will ask about your faith. If you answer Shahada, you will wait in peace. If not, you will be beaten with clubs until the Last Day.
- Others say that your soul hovers above the grave until the Last Day.
- Others claim your soul simply sleeps, so that it will only seem like a moment between death and being raised from the grave.



## 5 Heaven & Hell

The Qur'an paints some vivid pictures:

- Heaven is al'Jannah (the Garden) with flowers, rivers, streams and plants.
- Hell is Jahannan (the Fire) and is the place of horrors. People are chained up, given boiling water and puss to drink, and given clothes of fire to wear. Boiling water is poured over their heads. When their skin is too burnt to feel pain, they are given new skin.
