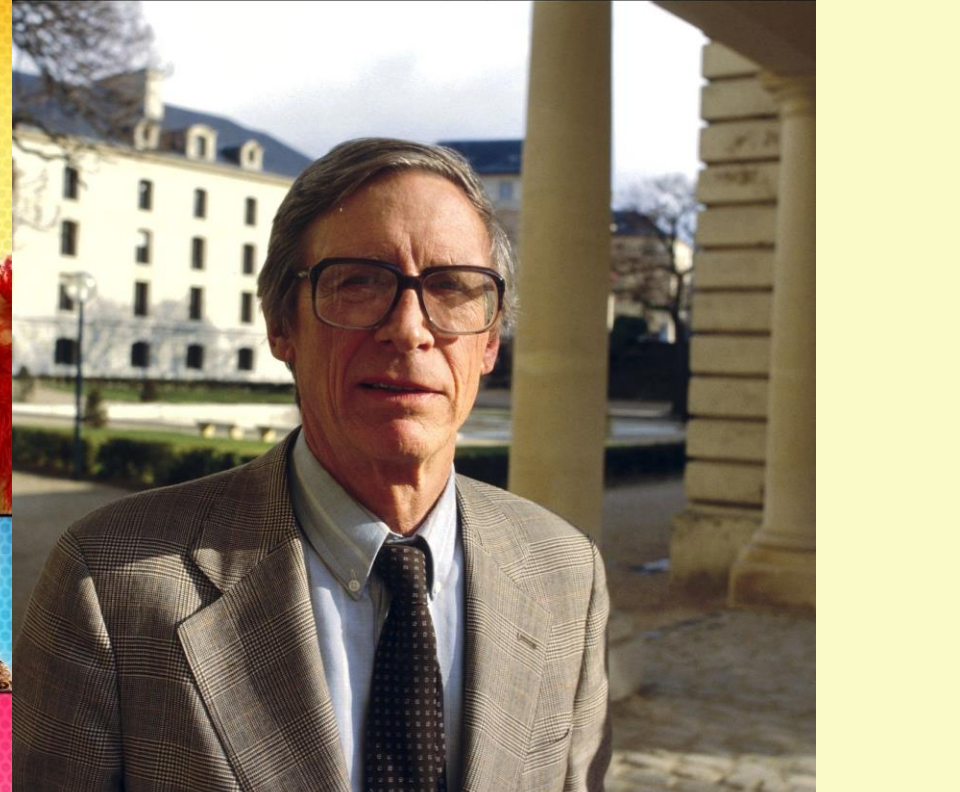

- **It is located in the debate and deliberation in the process**

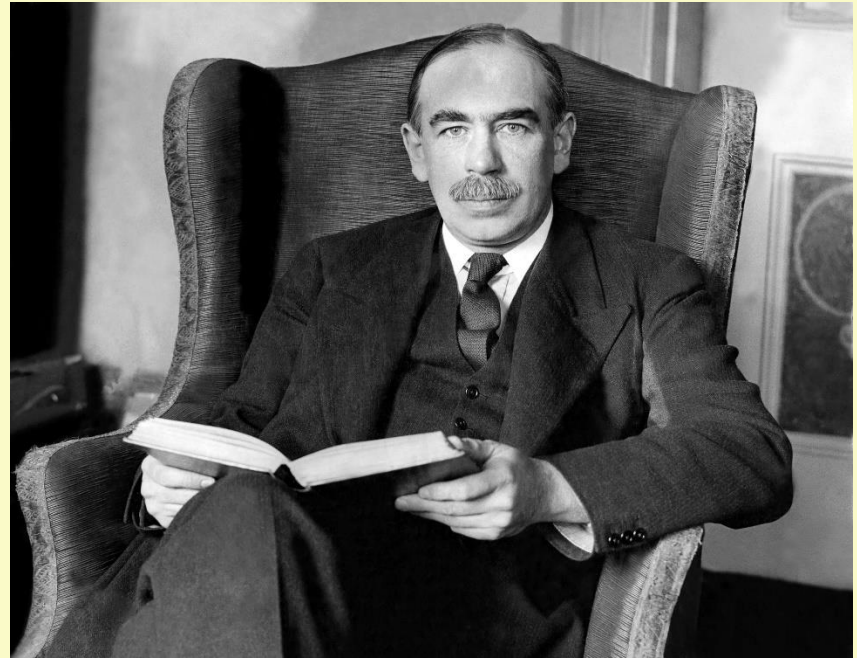

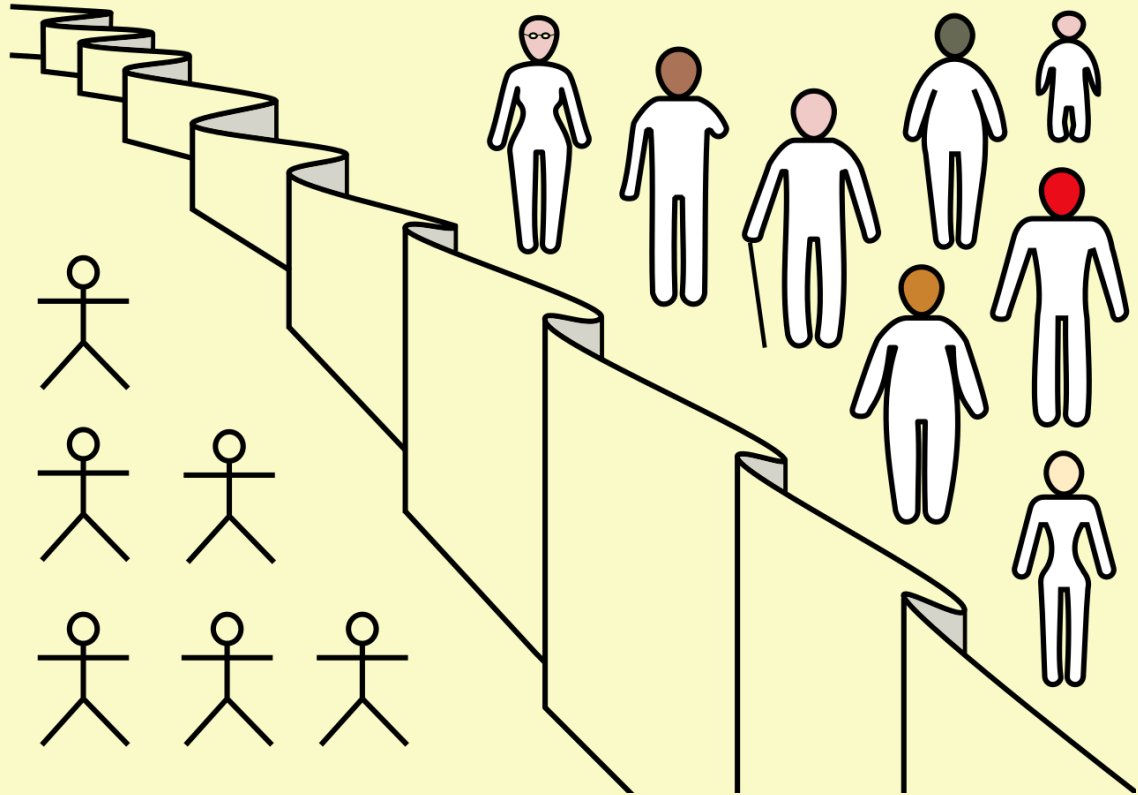
Society
