"Whoever does good, whether male or female, and is a believer, they will enter Paradise." (Qur'an 40:40)

This means that if you're a good person and you believe in Allah, you'll go to a wonderful place called Paradise when you die. It doesn't matter if you're a boy or a girl, everyone has a chance to go there.

"Indeed, your Lord is Allah Who created the heavens and the earth in six Days." (Qur'an 7:54)

This tells us that Allah, who is like a master creator, made the entire universe – the sky, the Earth, everything – in six days.

"Allah is the one who created you, then provided for you, then will cause you to die, and then will give you life." (Qur'an 30:40)

This explains that Allah made us, gives us everything we need to live, and will one day take our lives away. But it also says that He will bring us back to life again.

"Allah, Who created the heavens and the earth... is able to give life to the dead." (Qur'an 46:33)

This reminds us that Allah is so powerful that He can even bring people back to life after they've died.

This is like a prayer, asking Allah to forgive any mistakes we've made and to keep us safe from a place called the Fire, which is like a punishment.

"And remember when We said to the angels, 'Prostrate before Adam,' so they all did—but not Iblis, who refused and acted arrogantly." (Qur'an 2:34)

This tells the story of when Allah told the angels to bow down to Adam, the first human. They all obeyed, except for Iblis (who is like a devil) who was too proud and refused.

"He is the Knowing Creator." (Qur'an 36:81)

This simply means that Allah knows everything and is the one who created all things.
